Requirements

The Salesforce Developer/ Administrator will be responsible for a variety of tasks, which include: providing individual and group trainings to non-technical members of staff; design, architecture, configuration, development and administration of new and applications; designing roles ad permissions structures; creating and managing reports and customization needed.

- Design, develop, code, test and debug salesforce applications (including custom objects, fields, workflows, controls, queries, and APIs)
- Serve as primary Salesforce.com administrator and maintain the integrity of the system.
- Evaluate new tools as they become available on the Force.com platform.
- Serve as a knowledge resource for Salesforce.com capabilities and best practices and working closely with business partners to realize the full capabilities of Salesforce.com CRM
- Review and understand general business drivers and context for development projects and assist business users and others in defining required features and mapping salseforce features to business processes.
- Prepare and configure working functional prototypes as needed.
- Prepare and present user manual and training documentations and conduct users and administrators training session.
