Position Overview

The Director, Collective Action will help shape and deliver the Mobile Hub's strategy for enabling the digital development community's coordination and adoption of good practice through collaboration. S/he will refine the initial strategies for the Principles for Digital Development and reinforce the existing community of partners in this initiative in order to expand its reach and impact. The Director also will work closely with the CEO and other Mobile Hub executive team members to refine the services it offers to funders, including mechanisms for coordination and co-investment. S/he also will refine the approach to creating and adding value through fit-for-purpose Working Groups and other community-level groups that support the Mobile Hub program and investment areas. Finally, the Director will create and manage mechanisms to ensure strategic client relationship management across the Mobile Hub teams, enabling internal coordination and optimization in its approach to engaging with the digital ecosystem.

Mobile Hub Overview

The Mobile Hub is a new, \$75 million global alliance to enable the digital ecosystem to deliver greater scale, efficiency and social impact as it creates more inclusive digital economies in emerging markets. Working with partners, the Mobile Hub will generate evidence of what works through a series of demonstration projects, distil insights and tools to promote scale-up and replication, and provide mechanisms to encourage knowledge sharing, collaboration and co-investment throughout the ecosystem.

The Mobile Hub is a donor-funded program hosted within the UN Foundation, and based in the UN Foundation's Washington, D.C. office. The incumbent will be an employee of the UN Foundation and in most cases, will be based in Washington. In cases where a non-U.S. location is agreed, candidates will be hired on a long-term contract basis. In any case, candidates must have prior work authorization.
