Position Overview

The Director, Mobile Data for Development will help shape and deliver the Mobile Hub's strategy for realizing the potential of mobile phone-generated data to improve international development decision-making and delivery. The Mobile Hub's Mobile Data for Development program will develop, implement and distil practical lessons from a portfolio of demonstration projects in African and Asian markets. The Director will identify and work closely with partners to manage this project portfolio, at times providing hands-on expertise and at other times sourcing and delivering success through grantees or consultants. S/he will directly contribute intellectual capital to the sector so that s/he and the Mobile Hub serves as a thought leader and resource for the community.

Mobile Hub Overview

The Mobile Hub is a new, \$75 million global alliance to enable the digital ecosystem to deliver greater scale, efficiency and social impact as it creates more inclusive digital economies in emerging markets. Working with partners, the Mobile Hub will generate evidence of what works through a series of demonstration projects, distil insights and tools to promote scale-up and replication, and provide mechanisms to encourage knowledge sharing, collaboration and co-investment throughout the ecosystem.

The Mobile Hub is a donor-funded program hosted within the UN Foundation, and based in the UN Foundation's Washington, D.C. office. The incumbent will be an employee of the UN Foundation and in most cases, will be based in Washington. In cases where a non-U.S. location is agreed, candidates will be hired on a long-term contract basis. In any case, candidates must have prior work authorization.
