

Call for Applications: NPGH Fogarty Global Health Fellows



The Global Health Fellowship Program is an 12-month clinical research training program for post-doctorate trainees and doctoral students in the health professions, sponsored by the NIH Fogarty International Center.

Overview



Trainees spend 12 months at their research sites.



Trainees work closely with mentors domestically and abroad.



Trainees receive a monthly stipend, a modest research budget, health insurance, and travel costs to and from their international site.

Eligibility



Must be a citizen or permanent resident of: the United States, Peru, Ghana, Cameroon, Kenya, Uganda, India or Thailand.



Must be enrolled in or have completed a doctoral degree program or currently engaged in a post-doctoral fellowship or clinical residency
